

How Do Requirements Get Into Degree Tracker?

New Programs

As new programs are approved through the curriculum process in each college/school, the OUR is notified, and the Technology Support Services (TSS) Team creates a new program code. The DT Team is notified of the new program code and contacts the academic department/school for details. The DT Team works with the academic department/school to create a DT report that best meets their needs.

Existing Programs

As existing programs are updated, the DT Team must be notified to ensure students' degree audits are current and accurate. Substantive changes approved through the formal curriculum process should be sent to the DT Team by the college/school curriculum official. Smaller changes approved in the academic department (e.g., additions to elective lists) should be sent to the DT Team by the program director or coordinator. All changes should be sent as soon as possible to ensure the DT report is updated before the effective date.

The process of entering exceptions, or manual overrides, through the interactive report is an Emory customization that was added in 2019. The customization dramatically simplified the task and made it more accessible, empowering academic department users by enabling them to enter exceptions themselves.
