- Program = Undergraduate programs are BBA (Business), LIBAS (UCOL), AA (Oxford), and BSN (Nursing). Graduate programs often mirror the degree type (ex: MA, PHD, DPT, JD).
- Plan = Major, Minor, or Certificate
- Area Depth = Concentration or Track, if any exist; not all plans have Area Depths
